Instructions for use

Electric Confetti Canon 1 Shot (EFF510)

- Dimensions: 15cm x 20cm x 21cm
- Weight: 3.6Kg
- Voltage; 240volt
- Power: 25watt
- Spray Range: dependent on Canon Cartridges used
- DMX Controllable


Electric Confetti Canon 2 shot (EFF512)


- Dimensions: 30cm x 20cm x 21cm
- Weight: 6.8Kg
- Voltage: 240volt
- Spray Range: dependent on Canon Cartridges used
- DMX Controllable

To obtain the best performance from your electric canons please read the instructions before use.

- 1. Before use please check the machine to ensure no damage has occurred during transit, in the event of any damage do not use the product and contact your dealer.
- 2. This machine is designed to be used in conjunction with the range of Electric Canons either streamers of confetti products which are purchased separately.
- 3. When using the product aim above the heads of people, never point the product at a person.







- 1. Electric Confetti/Streamer Cable Socket
- 2. Holder for Confetti/Streamer Canon
- 3. LED Indicator on Canon Connection (Green-OK, Red-No)
- 4. DMX Dip Switches to address DMX
- 5. DMX In and Out Connection (XLR)
- 6. Angle Adjusment Knob
- 7. Power Indicator (Red is "On")
- 8. Power Con Input socket (240v)
- 9. Power Con Output socket (240v)

OPERATION:

- 1. Place the machine where required and adjust the angle of firing using the adjustable knob (6).
- 2. Connect the machine via DMX cables (5).
- 3. Connect the power cables (8/9) and switch on, the power LED will illuminate and the DMX indicator (green) will illuminate. You can adjust the DMX channel setting using the **dip switches (4).** Each unit is a single channel DMX, the two shot machine will be 2 channels of DMX.
- 4. Place your electric streamer or confetti Canon in the **holder (2)** and tighten the screw.
- 5. Place the cable from the electric Canon into the **Cable Socket (1)** the indicator will illuminate green if all operational.
- 6. You can fire the machine from your DMX controller by engaging the DMX channel you have selected.
- 7. After firing disconnect the power supply and remove the spent Canons.
- 8. Reload if you wish to use again and follow the above procedure.





TROUBLESHOOTING

| PROBLEM | REASON | SOLUTION |

| Power Indicator is not "ON", no power | Power cable is not connected | Check power cable |
| Indicator on the Canon is not illuminated when canon is connected. | Electric Confetti/Streamer Canon is no good | Change the Electric Canon for a replacement and reconnect. |
| The Unit shows Power on but does not work | DMX Cable is not connected | Check the DMX connections |
| | DMX address has not been set or exceeds 512 | Set the correct DMX address |
| Confetti Spray is not high enough | Problem with the Electric Canon | Change the Electric Canon |
| The Electric Canon is not firing in the correct sequence | DMX Cable is not Connected | Check the cabling and DMX address |
